## Minutes of the Executive Council Meeting

held on Saturday, 14 October 2017 at Llanelltud Village Hall.

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1. **WELCOME:** The Chairman welcomed all the members to the meeting and noted our sadness at losing 4 prominent members of the Society during the year; Lord Gwilym Prys Davies; Pegi Lloyd-Williams, Nan Griffiths and Dr Iwan Bryn Williams.

2. **MINUTES OF COUNCIL MEETING:** The Minutes were accepted.

### 3. MATTERS ARISING:

- (i) **Peter A Jones, our auditor:** it was felt that we should recognize our auditor's work in some way, the Chair noted that he would action this.
- (ii) **Storage of Technical Equipment:** the Record Office at Dolgellau are willing to store our equipment but at our own risk. It was confirmed that they would need a letter stating the individual numbers of the various items to avoid any confusion regarding them.
- (iii) **e-mails:** those members who have supplied their e-mail addresses were thanked. The Society has used them to save a considerable amount on postage.

4. **CORRESPONDENCE:** The following correspondence was referred to –  
(i) An application for funding by 'Discovering Old Welsh Houses' for £500. Following a detailed discussion regarding concerns when a charity gives funds to another charity and the legal implications of doing so, the meeting asked the officers to look into the matter to ensure we can contribute.

(ii) Request by John Townsend for 'Discovering Old Welsh Houses' for permission to copy various materials published by the Society to be used in their research. Following a discussion regarding copyright, the officers, again, were asked to look into the matter.

5. **ACCOUNTS:** The Treasurer presented his Report for the year and expressed his gratitude to Pamela Michael and Megan Huggins for their work as Membership Secretaries. He also thanked Nereus of Bala for the preparation of the balance sheet and to Peter A Jones for his work as auditor. He referred the members to the balance sheet stating that there had been a reduction in the number of members and that interest rates had decreased by 2% over three years. He informed the meeting that he has looked into accounts that offer better interest rates but very significant sums would have to be invested to benefit from the higher interest rates and it was considered to be better to leave things as they are at present. He referred to the fact that the Index to the *Journal* and the project on the First World War had incurred costs in this financial year. He mentioned that the best format for the next Index should be decided and that we should consider the stock of back-issues of the *Journal* stored at the Record Office as they are substantial. Our income has decreased but the insurance payment is higher due to the new equipment bought and that insurance premiums have increased in general. To close, it was stated that the Society had run at a loss in the last financial year. A question was raised from the floor regarding the stocks of back-issues, asking if we should consider selling at a reduced price. The Chairman expressed our gratitude to the Treasurer and Peter A Jones for their meticulous work.

6. **THE ANNUAL REPORT:** The Annual Report was presented to the members. It was resolved to recommend that the AGM should accept the report.

7. **MEMBERSHIP:** Megan Huggins opened her report by thanking Dr Pamela Michael for her work over the years. She referred the members to the Annual Report stating that there had been a small decrease in the number of members. A new Membership Form has been produced and a new Standing Order and they are available on our website. The Chairman thanked the Secretary for her report.

8. **THE JOURNAL:** The Editor also referred to the Annual Report, stating that the *Journal* has now been distributed. Our gratitude to Aeron Jones and the printers was expressed and to all the contributors for being so dependable. Two articles have already been received for the next edition, but none in Welsh so far.

9. **MEETINGS:** The Meetings Organiser referred to the various meetings held during the year, our visit to Aberystwyth to commemorate the death of Robert Vaughan; Andrew Wolfe's lecture in June and the visit to Caer-gai in July. The Chairman thanked Gwerfyl for her diligent work in arranging the meetings and also for her contribution in translating at many of the meetings.
