Minutes of the Annual General Meeting 2015
held on Saturday, 10 October 2015 at the Village Hall, Llanelltud.

*The Chair welcomed the members and guests to the
Annual General Meeting.*

APOLOGIES: Hugh G Roberts; Nan Griffiths, Vivian Parry Williams; Steffan ab Owain; A L Darbyshire, Dr Elizabeth Andrews; Hefin Birch; Gaynor Pugh; Aled Ellis; and Catherine Lloyd Griffiths.

- 1. The Minutes of the 2014 Annual General Meeting were approved.**
- 2. Matters arising from the Minutes:** None
- 3. Summary of the Council meeting:** The discussions were summarised explaining the situation regarding *History of Merioneth* Vol III and the difficulties in progressing the project. It was suggested from the floor that the funds could be used to publish other materials associated with the County's history. The Annual General Meeting confirmed the Council's recommendation.
- 4. Accounts for the year ending 31 March 2015:** The Final Accounts were accepted (see the Treasurer's comments in the Council Minutes). A member emphasised the importance of supplying e-mail addresses to save postage costs. The Treasurer was thanked for his thorough and detailed work.
- 5. Annual Report:** The report was confirmed as correct.
- 6. Membership Report:** The Membership Secretary presented her report (see Council Minutes) and the Society's appreciation of all Pamela's work in unpicking this very complex matter was expressed.
- 7. The Journal:** The Editor stated that the proofs were with the Printers and that the *Journal* will include 5 articles, 4 short contributions, proceedings and 8 reviews. He stated that he had already received 1 article for the next issue. There are 10 CD's of the index still available and work on indexing the next volumes, 5 volumes in all, will start at the end of the year. The Chairman referred to the valuable material contained in the *Journal* annually and thanked the Editor for his diligent work.
- 8. Meetings Organiser:** The Organiser summarised the year's activities (see Council Minutes) and the Chairman expressed our appreciation of her work.
- 8. Election of Officers:** The Council's decision to recommend Arwyn Lloyd Hughes as Vice President as an indication of our appreciation of his work was confirmed. The election of Catherine James as a member for Dolgellau on the Council and Jenny Lees to represent Edeirnion were also confirmed. It was stated that there are still vacancies on the Council for Ystumanner and the list of officers recommended by the Council was confirmed (see Council Minutes).
- 9. Any Other Business:** The members' attention was drawn to the books available for sale at the meeting. The concerns regarding Pont ar Ddyfi were mentioned.

The Chairman closed the business meeting by thanking everyone for their support and also expressed our appreciation of the translator's work.

During the remainder of the afternoon Brian Slyfield gave an extremely interesting introduction to the books of Merioneth. The members were very appreciative of the opportunity to leaf through some of the most notable books. Rheinalt Llwyd gave a vote of thanks on our behalf for drawing our attention to the County's important contribution in this field.
