FINANCE: [Rheinallt Llwyd]

As can be seen from the Accounts for 2013-14 there was a very small surplus (£11.36) at the end of the financial year and this reflects a considerable problem facing the Society, namely a reduction in its income but increases in its costs. Therefore, recruiting new members is crucially important to ensure the future well-being of the Society. On a more positive note, however, the news, at the end of April 2014, that the Society had been awarded a grant of up to £4,200 by the Heritage Lottery Fund to undertake specific activities was extremely encouraging.

MEMBERSHIP REPORT 01:09:13 – 31:08:14:[Pamela Michael]

Since my last report we have gained 15 new members, comprising 13 single and 2 family members. Three members have died. This means that the membership which stood at 227 last year should now stand at 239. This number includes 7 life members, 44 life members and 188 single members. In addition there are 24 institutional members, mainly libraries and public institutions. Some of these have not paid their subscriptions and invoices and reminders have now been dispatched. **However, the situation is much less favourable than might appear from these statistics, since a large number of members (in excess of thirty) are in arrears with their subscriptions.** Some of these may have decided not to renew their membership, but failed to inform the society of their intention to resign. Most members now pay by standing order, which saves a great deal of work in chasing up subscriptions. Some members who pay by cheque send their remittance to the society in April each year without fail. There are a few members who sometimes forget and then respond with a cheque for two years on receipt of a reminder. When members fail to respond in any way to a second request, then I think that we have no alternative but to remove them from the membership list. Therefore, if the arrears are not collected by next April, I think it likely that in next year's annual report we may see a sharp drop in numbers. **It is therefore more important than ever that we try to recruit new members.**

ACTIVITIES: [Rhian Parry]

- **WORKSHOP AT LLANELLTUD** A workshop was held for the members at Llanelltud Village Hall on Tuesday, 12 November 2013 Over 30 members and friends attended to discuss ideas for the 2014 programme. Three members gave presentations, Pam Michael, Neil Evans and Vivian Parry Williams. The theme was Remembrance, looking at some of the effects of the Great War on Merionethshire. Through the presentations it became apparent that more time is needed to discuss, research and record. It was decided to arrange an open day 'Remembrance and Scars' as part of the 2014 programme and to apply for a Heritage Lottery Grant for funds to arrange a number of activities. Also, the members suggested a number of other events, lectures and visits and we hope to include some, at least in future.

- **CERRIGYDRUDION MEETING, 5 APRIL 2014** The Society's Welsh meeting was held jointly with the Denbighshire Historical Society at Cerrigydrudion, when Dr Angharad Price gave a lecture on 'T.H. Parry Williams'.
- **DAY SCHOOL 'SCARS OF WAR', 26 APRIL 2014** A one-day school was held at Plas Tan-y-bwlch, Maentwrog. This was part of the Society's plans to discuss some of the Great War's effects on Merioneth and to focus on remembering and learning. Neil Evans presented a number of questions, how did the residents of Merioneth respond at the beginning of the war, what was the scale of the opposition and what was the response to the local recruitment campaign? Vivian Parry-Williams presented evidence from local newspapers, the result of his recent work recording the feelings of those who contributed articles and poetry. Pam Michael then described the effects of the war on the women of Merioneth, especially those who worked on the land. Catherine James described her father's history, a Conscientious Objector, and the way he was treated by the state and his community. During the afternoon, Arwyn Lloyd Hughes gave a presentation on his grandfather, Hugh Thomas Hughes (1887-1918) and then the members joined in an open forum.
- **BALA TOUR, 7 JUNE 2014** The members were treated to a very interesting tour of the old Bala lead by Buddug Medi and Peris Jones Evans. The tour was followed by a visit to Berwynfa and then to Plas yn Dre for refreshments.
- **ONE DAY SCHOOL – 'BONHEDDWYR MAWR OR' BALA', 21 JUNE 2014** Some of the Society's members were present and lectures were given by Beryl H Griffiths and Pam Michael and Rhian Parry gave a presentation, in a programme arranged by the Institute for the Study of Welsh Estates, Bangor University.
- **A VISIT TO LLANEGRYN CHURCH, 6 SEPTEMBER 2014** The Society was invited to join the Friends of the Church for a talk by Haydn Rees and to visit the church.

THE JOURNAL: [A. Lloyd Hughes]

This year's Journal (Vol. XVII, Part I) will be despatched to the membership in October/ November. The issue will comprise five lengthy articles, two short contributions, 'Proceedings of the Society, 2013' and three reviews. It will be around 126 pages long and will contain eleven illustrations. There is some material already in hand for next year's Journal.

THE WEBSITE: As the development of the website was part of the Heritage Lottery Bid work is progressing on finding a company to re-vamp the website.

Ers fy adroddiad diwethaf rydym wedi cael 15 o aelodau newydd, sef 13 o aelodau unigol a 2 o aelodau teuluol. Bu tri aelod farw. Mae hyn yn golygu y dylai'r aelodaeth oedd yn 227 y llynedd fod yn 239 erbyn hyn. Mae'r cyfanswm yn cynnwys 7 aelod oes, 44 aelod teuluol ac 188 o aelodau unigol.
