## Minutes of the Council Meeting

held on Saturday, 11 October 2014 at Llanelltud Village Hall.

**1. Welcome:** The Chair welcomed the members to the meeting.

**2. Minutes of Council Meeting:** The Minutes were accepted on condition that the name of Leslie Derbyshire should be added to the list of Council members.

**3. Matters arising from the minutes:** There were no matters arising from the minutes that were not on the agenda.

**4. Correspondence:** Reference was made to the following letters –

i. The resignation of Geraint F Roberts as Vice-Chair, our appreciation of his long and invaluable service to the Society was expressed. It was decided to recommend that Geraint F Roberts should become a Vice-President of the Society.

ii. A letter from the Institute Research of Welsh Estates inviting a representative to their meeting on 13 November. Rhian Parry was proposed.

**5. Accounts:** Accounts: The Treasurer presented his Report for the year and expressed his appreciation to the members for their loyalty and especially those who pay through direct debit. He summarised the year by saying that there had been a reduction in income and an increase in costs. He referred to the wave-like pattern of subscriptions and that, unfortunately we were seeing the trough this year. He noted that it is more difficult for public bodies to pay subscriptions. It was a good year as regards interest rates but they are being lowered at present. He referred to Gift Aid and that the rules had been tightened severely but that the officers are still working on this. He referred to the grant received from CADW and expressed our gratitude for the grant and to Arwyn Lloyd Hughes for securing it. Our costs as a society are increasing but there was a small surplus over the last year. The Treasurer referred to the Heritage Lottery Grant received to work on the First World War. He thanked Peter Jones for auditing the accounts.

*The Chair thanked Rheinallt for his detailed and careful work.*

**6. The Annual Report:** The Council Members' attention was drawn to the report and the Membership Secretary's comments regarding arrears and the need for new members. Reference was made to the Events Organisers' report and the Organiser added to it by mentioning events such as the Conference at Tan-y-Bwlch and the hope that we can co-operate with the People's Collection to upload material about Merioneth onto the web. It was resolved to recommend that the AGM should accept the report.

**7. Membership:** In the absence of the Membership Secretary reference was made to her report in the Annual Report and the need for new members and to ensure that institutions pay their subscriptions.

**8. The Journal:** The Editor reported that the third set of proofs had been returned and that the Journal was on its way to the printers. He also stated that material was in hand for next year. The Editor expressed his gratitude to all the contributors and the Chair, in turn, thanked the Editor for his tireless work on the Journal.

**9. Events:** The Events Organiser gave a summary of the events already lined up for next year and to the meeting on 11 November. The Chair expressed the Society's gratitude to the Organiser for all her work, stating that the prospects for the next year appeared to be very good indeed.

**10. History of Merioneth:** Neil Evans presented the latest information regarding the Volume. He stated that Nia Watkin Powell apologised that she could not be present but that they had met. He summarised the problems that they face as editors as they cannot fund contributions and that lecturers have other priorities due to the change of emphasis in Universities. Neil Evans stated that they now considered it would be better to concentrate on one volume at first and that this would be easier to realise. He stated that all the contributors for the third volume were in place and listed them as follows:

The Chair expressed our thanks to Neil for his report and a number of questions were asked from the floor regarding the publication date, for example, Neil noted that he would expect to receive the contributions during 2016. He noted that the editors needed a decision as to how to progress. It was mentioned that contributions could be invited and that a Lottery bid could be created for publication funding.

*It was proposed that a meeting of the sub-committee should be called to discuss the matters above and to give their recommendation.*

**11. The Website:** The Trustees had received two quotes for the work and that the recommended that the quote given by Llyr Edwards of Llanuwchllyn should be accepted. It was resolved to recommend this to the AGM.
